Applied Logistics Services, Incorporated, (ALS) announced today that it was awarded a task order under its SeaPort Enhanced (SeaPort-e) contract by the Commander, Naval Air Systems Command in Patuxent River, Maryland. SeaPort-e is an online contracting system that provides electronic procurement of logistics, engineering, technical, and other professional support services for all commands within the Naval Enterprise including the Naval Sea Systems Command, the Naval Air Systems Command, the Space and Naval Warfare Systems Command, the Supply Systems Command, Military Sealift Command, Naval Facilities Engineering Command, Strategic Systems Programs, the U.S. Marine Corps, and the Defense Threat Reduction Agency (DTRA).

ALS was the successful bidder on an Indefinite Delivery/Indefinite Quantity (ID/IQ) contract for logistics and technical support services to the U.S. Navy sonobuoy program for the Program Executive Office, Air Antisubmarine Warfare, Assault, and Special Mission programs (PMA-264). Total value of the five-year contract is \$2.74M if all options are exercised.
